It encourages participants to explore diverse themes, techniques, and formats, without restricting creativity to a specific size or technique, as long as the work does not exceed 40 inner pages. This openness to innovation and diversity in submissions ensures a wide range of entries, enriching the competition and providing young readers with access to a varied and vibrant selection of picture books. By accepting entries in any of the official languages of the Iberian Peninsula, the prize also celebrates linguistic diversity, making it a truly international competition.

The collaboration between the City Council of Santiago de Compostela and Kalandraka publishers brings a significant level of expertise and recognition to the competition, positioning the International COMPOSTELA Prize as a leading award in the field of children's literature. This partnership not only amplifies the reach and prestige of the award but also ensures that the winning entries receive professional publication and distribution. As such, the COMPOSTELA Prize for Picture Books serves as an invaluable platform for emerging and established authors and illustrators, offering them the opportunity to gain international exposure and contribute to the rich, diverse world of children's literature.

Eligibility

Open to authors of any nationality, except winners from previous years and current or former employees of Kalandraka.

Prize

The winner of the contest will receive a €9000 prize, with the winning work being published in Galician, Catalan, Basque, Castilian Spanish, and Portuguese by Kalandraka in November 2024.
