The culmination of the competition will be marked by a physical exhibition at the Bolu Abant Izzet Baysal University's art gallery on 3 December 2024, coinciding with World Disability Day. In addition to the exhibition, a digital catalogue of the selected works will be published, providing lasting visibility and recognition for the designers. Participants whose works are chosen for the exhibition will receive a digital participation certificate, while the top three designs will be awarded a symbolic BIAH Certificate of Achievement. The overall winner will gain the prestigious opportunity to serve on the jury for the next BIAH event, further contributing to the ongoing dialogue on disability and inclusion.

All participants whose works are accepted for the exhibition will receive a digital participation certificate. The top three designers will receive a symbolic digital BIAH Certificate of Achievement, and the winner will have the opportunity to participate as a jury member in the next BIAH event.
