The exhibition is hosted at the 28 Piazza di Pietra Fine Art Gallery, an internationally recognized venue that blends modernity with the historical setting of the ancient Hadrian Temple ruins. This annual exhibition draws an international audience, including art collectors and enthusiasts, offering photographers unparalleled visibility and the chance to engage with a global art community.

Beyond the exhibition, the Passepartout Photo Prize offers additional benefits that further enhance the profile of the winning photographers. These include publication opportunities in the competition's annual catalogue and various partner magazines, as well as the chance to be featured in an online gallery and across social media platforms. The prize also includes a special sponsored award, the CSF Adams Prize, which provides a portfolio review and workshop, helping photographers refine their craft under expert guidance. This combination of awards and exposure makes the Passepartout Photo Prize a valuable opportunity for photographers looking to advance their careers and gain international recognition.

Entry fee: 25 euros for up to 3 images; additional images (up to 10 total) can be submitted for 4 euros each.

Eligibility

Open to photographers from all over the world without any age restrictions.

Prize

The prize includes a total of 1,000 euros distributed among winners, with the main prize being 500 euros. Winners also receive the opportunity to exhibit their work in a collective exhibition at the 28 Piazza di Pietra Fine Art Gallery in Rome. Additional prizes include a portfolio review and workshop through the CSF Adams Prize, as well as features in partner publications and online platforms.
