Due to the U.S. export regulations this contest is not open to any resident of the following countries: Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, and Syria.

Prize

Grand Prize Winners will receive **Adobe software** and a cash prize up to **US\$5,000**. The top three finalists of each category will be announced in *September 2014*.
