Beyond the competition itself, the Aesthetica Art Prize offers a significant professional development opportunity through exhibition, publication and media visibility. Selected artists benefit from showcasing their work to international curators, collectors, gallery directors and art industry professionals, strengthening their presence in the global art market. With its strong reputation, international reach and commitment to supporting creative talent, the Aesthetica Art Prize 2026 stands as a key opportunity for artists seeking recognition, visibility and meaningful engagement within the contemporary arts sector.

Entry fee: The standard entry fee is £25 (rising to £35 for late entries between 1-6 September 2026).

Eligibility

Open to artists worldwide of any experience level and age, with a specific Emerging Prize category encouraging current students and recent graduates.

Prize

The prize awards a £10,000 Main Prize and a £1,000 Emerging Prize, with winners also gaining a group exhibition in a major public gallery, editorial coverage in Aesthetica Magazine and online, and profiles on the Aesthetica website; shortlisted and longlisted artists receive exhibition and publication opportunities that further visibility and career engagement.
