Eligibility

Open to all photographers worldwide.

Prize

The Grand Prize winner will receive £3,500 along with the prestigious title of Bird Photographer of the Year. Category winners receive a £500 cash prize. Special awards, such as the Conservation Award and the Portfolio Award, recognize collections of images, while the Young Bird Photographer of the Year title celebrates the best young talent across three age groups.
