The event's commitment to education and cultural transmission further enhances its role as a crucial platform for the next generation of photographers, making it an essential event in the European photographic calendar.

The entry fee is €20.

Eligibility

Open to all photographers of European nationality or residents in Europe at the start of their careers who have not had a major exhibition in France.

Prize

Selected photographers will have their work exhibited at CENTQUATRE-PARIS and other locations, gaining significant exposure. The festival provides a platform for networking with industry professionals, portfolio reviews, and workshops. It serves as a springboard for artists, offering opportunities to engage with a broad audience and further their careers in the photographic arts.
