The contest organizers emphasize the importance of understanding the theme deeply, encouraging participants to read the provided brief and related materials to enhance their conceptual approach.

The Escucha Mi Voz Poster Contest 2024 does not offer monetary prizes but provides significant opportunities for recognition and exposure. The top 50 posters, selected by an esteemed international jury, will be featured in traveling exhibitions across various countries, including the United States, China, and Iran. This extensive exposure allows artists to showcase their work on a global stage, highlighting the contest's commitment to fostering a community of socially engaged artists. Selected participants will receive a digital certificate and have the opportunity to be featured in an electronic edition of their poster, further amplifying their message and reach.
