• Display typefaces

Eligible are all typefaces that have been designed or digitized after 2011 and meet the competition requirements. All submitted fonts must comply with and use the Unicode encoding system. Submissions can be single fonts or type families.

Entry fee: 20 Euro (approx. 26,50 USD)

Eligibility

All type designers from all parts of the world are invited to take part in the competition

Prize

In each of the seven categories up to **three certificates** will be awarded, and a jury of international experts will award the **Grand Prize Granshan 2013**, including prize money of 1,000 Euro (approx. 1,300 USD).

Moreover, printed examples of the winning entries will be published in a documentation designed by tgm.

The winners will be announced at a press conference held by the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Armenia in Yerevan in the month of *November*.
