Each participant is allowed to submit a maximum of two posters, offering a platform to display versatility and breadth in design. The requirement for submissions includes a dual-format presentation: a physical copy printed and mounted on a 50 x 70 cm foam board and a digital version saved in high resolution on a USB. This submission criterion ensures that the artworks are not only visually appealing but also versatile for various applications, from print to digital media. The competition not only celebrates the artistic talent but also bridges the gap between art and commercial branding, highlighting the role of design in marketing and brand identity.

The International Biennial Poster Design Terras Gauda – Francisco Mantecón Competition 2024 stands out in the international art and design landscape for its commitment to fostering creativity and innovation in poster design. By providing a free-to-enter platform, it invites a diverse array of talents from individuals aged 18 and over, regardless of their professional background or geographical location. This inclusivity enriches the competition with a wide range of perspectives and styles, elevating the standard and diversity of submissions. As artists vie for the grand prize and honorable mentions, their works contribute to a vibrant showcase of contemporary design and artistic excellence, further cementing the competition's status as a key event in the international design calendar.

Open to anyone aged 18 or over.

Prize

The competition offers a Grand Prize of €10,000. Additionally, there is a 1st honorable mention and a 2nd honorable mention, each awarded €2,000, and a special mention also awarded €2,000.
