Jackson's Art Prize welcomes paintings, drawings, and original prints while outlining clear guidelines that exclude three-dimensional works, digital or AI art, pure photography, offensive subject matters, and specific digital prints. Entrants can present up to five artworks, fostering diverse creative expression within defined parameters.

Jackson's Art Prize encourages artists to showcase their current or lifelong bodies of work, promoting a community-driven approach that values artistic freedom. This competition serves as a catalyst for recognition, reflecting a commitment to artistic excellence, accessibility, and diversity. Its evolution over the years signifies a dedication to celebrating artistic vision and innovation, contributing to the growth and acknowledgment of emerging talents in the art world.

The entry fee is £6 per artwork.

Eligibility

Artists of all abilities, ages, and from any location can enter the competition with 2D fine art pieces.

Prize

Jackson's Art Prize offers various awards, including a First Prize of £5000 + £2000 materials, a Second Prize of £3000 + £1000 materials, Runner-up prizes, Judge's Choice awards, and a People's Choice prize, all providing materials as rewards.
