Entry fee: Single image free; extra single images \$10 each; 5+ single images for \$35; a series entry (up to 10 images) costs \$45.

## Eligibility

Open worldwide to anyone aged 18 or over, professional or amateur photographers alike.

## Prize

The competition offers Cash Awards & Recognition including for Series category: 1st Place \$3,500; 2nd Place \$2,000; 3rd Place \$1,000; for Single Image category: 1st Place \$2,000; 2nd Place \$1,000; 3rd Place \$500. Beyond that, additional distinctions via Jurors' Picks and Finalists; the winners also get an exhibition in New York (2026), a solo feature on LensCulture, public exposure via the Editor's Picks and the online gallery, plus international press exposure.
