Eligibility

The contest is open to all primary and secondary school students aged 11-19. College and university students are not eligible.

Prize

Winners of the Science Without Borders Challenge will be awarded scholarships based on their placing: 1st Place will receive \$500, 2nd Place will get \$350, and 3rd Place will be awarded \$200. Additionally, there is a “People’s Choice” award, in which the winners from each age group will each receive a \$50 scholarship.
