Standard Entry: \hat{A} £25 - Minimum of 3 and up to a maximum of 10 images Student Entry: \hat{A} £10 - Minimum of 3 and up to a maximum of 10 images

Eligibility

Photographers must be over 18 years of age on 1st January 2013.

Prize

The winners will have their work showcased in Terry O'Neill exhibitions in *London* and overseas and will be featured in the Sunday Times Magazine.

£6500 (approx. 10,100 USD) of cash prizes can be won. The winner gets £3000 and two runners-up £2000 and £1000 respectively. The winner of the mobile device category wins £500.
