Each participant is permitted to submit up to three posters that have been produced since May 2022, ensuring that the works presented are fresh and reflective of current trends and styles in theatrical poster design. The Biennale emphasizes the importance of originality and adherence to human rights, categorically excluding any submissions that contain hate speech or contradict the principles of human dignity.

Enhanced by a meticulous selection process, the entries submitted to the Theatrical Posters International Biennale Armenia 2024 are evaluated by a distinguished pre-selection committee, followed by an international jury composed of esteemed figures in graphic design and the arts. This rigorous evaluation ensures that only the most impressive works are showcased, culminating in a vibrant exhibition that highlights the dynamic interplay between visual art and the performing arts. The TPAM Biennale is not just an event but a beacon for artistic excellence, drawing attention from the global arts community and offering unparalleled exposure for participants. It stands as a testament to the power of visual communication in celebrating and promoting the richness of theatrical and performance arts worldwide.

Eligibility

Open to all artists, designers, theatres/theatre groups, and organizations worldwide.

Prize

The international jury will award medals and diplomas for 1 Grand Prix and 2 The Best Poster awards. There will also be 2 Special Awards, 2 Honorable Mentions, and 3 Encouragement Certificates for self-promotion/rejected posters. Winners will receive a free hard copy of the catalogue, with the results announced in autumn 2024 during the opening ceremony in Yerevan. All shortlisted applicants will receive a digital certificate and PDF catalogue confirming their participation.
