Moreover, the competition emphasizes an extensive promotional campaign, ensuring that the artists' works receive broad recognition across various media channels.

For the 2024/2025 edition, YICCA aims to maintain its role as a critical stepping stone for contemporary artists, offering substantial financial rewards and professional development. Finalists not only gain recognition through the exhibition but also see their works published in the official YICCA catalog, which is widely distributed among art institutions and professionals. This makes the YICCA Art Prize a highly sought-after contest for artists looking to elevate their careers, access international art markets, and increase their visibility on a global scale.

Entry fee starts at €50 for one artwork, with increasing fees for additional submissions.

Eligibility

Open to all artists from any country.

Prize

The contest offers a cash prize of €3,000 for the first-place winner and €1,000 for the second-place winner. In addition to the financial rewards, selected artists will have their works exhibited in a prominent European gallery, providing them with exposure to key figures in the art world such as critics and gallery owners. Finalists will also have their works included in a professional catalog, enhancing their visibility within the international art community.
