For the partial support of the organisation expenses, the application fee is 100 Euro $+22 \%$ VAT. For under 25 artists the application fee is 80 Euro $+22 \%$ VAT with the obligation to attach a copy of the artist's ID card in the subscription.

Open to artists worldwide with no age restrictions.
