The **Arte Laguna Prize** is an international free-themed art competition aimed at enhancing *Contemporary Art*. Promoting contemporary art and providing artists with professional development opportunities are the founding principles of the competition.

There is **no thematic guidelines or any other restriction**, and its goal is to collect the multiple expressions of contemporary art in the fields of:

â€¢ **Painting**

â€¢ **Photography Art**

â€¢ **Sculpture and Installation**

â€¢ **Video Art and Short Films**

â€¢ **Performance**

â€¢ **Virtual Art**

â€¢ **Digital Graphics**

â€¢ **Land Art**

â€¢ **Urban Art**

â€¢ **Design**

The works will be evaluated and selected by a jury of international experts including directors of foundations and museums, independent curators, art critics, and chaired by *Igor Zanti*, curator of the Prize and director of **IED Venice**.

For the partial support of the organisation expenses, the application fee is 100 Euro + 22% VAT. For *under 25* artists the application fee is 80 Euro + 22% VAT with the obligation to attach a copy of the artist's ID card in the subscription.

Eligibility

Open to artists worldwide with no age restrictions.

Prize

An international jury will select **120 finalist artists** for:

â€¢ 4 cash prizes of 10.000 Euro each, for a total amount of 40.000 Euro

â€¢ Major collective exhibition in the *Arsenale of Venice*

â€¢ Exhibitions in international Art Galleries

â€¢ Collaborations with Companies

â€¢ Art Residencies

â€¢ International Festivals

â€¢ Prize Sustainability and Art

â€¢ Publication in the catalogue

The **major collective exhibition** will take place in the historical location of the Arsenale in Venice (*Italy*) in *March/April 2020*.
