Participants also gain valuable knowledge about climate change, develop skills in communication and advocacy, and become part of a global community focused on environmental justice and climate action. Cash awards of up to \$1,000 are available, and participants have the chance for involvement in programs like the Future Blue Youth Council, as well as opportunities to intern or serve as contest judges with Bow Seat.
