Prize

On May 25, 2015 the juries of experts and human rights defenders will select the winners at a plenary meeting.

On June 4, 2015 the award ceremony and the exhibition of the best works will be held in one of the public spaces

of Kyiv (Ukraine). After the end of the contest the information campaign to promote the winners' work will start.
