Open to illustrators over the age of 18 who have not yet published a children's book with an ISBN.

## Prize

Winners will sign a professional contract with Apila Ediciones for the publication of their fully illustrated picture book, receiving a €4,000 award (equivalent to 10% of the value of the first print run) along with international distribution of the book, providing both significant exposure and a platform to launch their careers.
