There are two main sections:

• Student

• Emerging and Established

The Student category is open to all full time students over 18 years of age worldwide. The Emerging and Established category is open to any newly practising illustrators who are wishing to gain exposure of their work and to those who are more established and are apart of the illustration world.

There is no entry fee.

Eligibility

Open worldwide to all students, emerging and established illustrators.
