Preferred subjects for photographs submitted are those focusing on courage, strength, leadership, kindness and the value that education has for boys and young men living in low-income communities worldwide, and related to the activities, mission and goals of *Life Pieces To Masterpieces*.

All forms of photographic medium are eligible.

Entry fee of US\$ 30.00 entitles each artist to submit up to 3 images.

Open to all photographers worldwide.

Prize

•1st prize: US\$ 1,000 plus a contest catalog

• 2nd prize: US\$ 750 plus a contest catalog • 3rd prize: US\$ 500 plus a contest catalog

• Two honorable mention awards: a contest catalog (no cash prize)

Moreover, a documentary-style exhibition will be produced from the 20 finalist photographs that will be exhibited at Pepco Edison Gallery in Washington DC during *October 2014* and subsequently in other venues.
