## Eligibility

Open worldwide to all designers, graphic and visual artists. No age limit.

## Prize

The best 30 to 50 posters will be selected by an international jury and will be part of traveling exhibitions in Mexico ( and probably in Latin American and North American countries as well).

Moreover, if your poster is selected you will have a free collection of postcards or print edition, only ask for cover the shipment and your participation certificate.

The names of the selected designers will be announced during the month of September 2019. The exhibitions will start in October 2019.
