Eligibility

Open worldwide to illustrators aged between 16 and 39 years.

Prize

The competition rewards a variety of prizes, including the Grand Award, which offers significant recognition. Finalists and winners receive substantial exposure by having their works displayed during the Shanghai International Children's Book Fair, and featured in the annual Golden Pinwheel Yearbook. Winners also have the opportunity for their illustrations to be viewed by a global audience.
