Beyond the awards themselves, the Hasselblad Masters competition offers long-term career value through extensive global exposure. Winning and shortlisted photographers benefit from international promotion via Hasselblad's official platforms, inclusion in the Hasselblad Masters Photography Book, and collaboration opportunities with the brand on future creative projects. Eligibility

Open to photographers worldwide using digital or film cameras (excluding drone, smartphone or tablet cameras), with a special Project // 21 category for entrants aged 21 and under.

Prize

Winners in each of the seven categories receive the title of Hasselblad Master, a Hasselblad X2D II 100C camera, two XCD lenses of their choice, a €5,000 cash prize, and the opportunity to collaborate with Hasselblad on new work for the Hasselblad Masters Photography Book with selected images showcased across Hasselblad's global channels, offering significant international exposure and professional prestige.
