The International Design Awards (IDA) 2026 is a global competition recognizing outstanding achievement across architecture, interior, product, graphic, and fashion design. Organized by the Farmani Group, the awards aim to celebrate visionary designers while also uncovering emerging talent from around the world. With nearly two decades of history, IDA has established itself as a respected international platform for multidisciplinary design excellence.

The competition invites professionals and students alike to submit completed projects across a wide range of categories and subcategories. Entries are evaluated by an international jury of design experts, with judging focused on creativity, innovation, execution, and overall impact. Designers are encouraged to present their work through strong visual documentation and clear project descriptions that communicate both concept and context.

Winning an IDA award offers designers global recognition within the design community and positions their work alongside leading international projects. The program highlights both established studios and new voices, making it a valuable opportunity for exposure and professional advancement in a competitive global industry.

Entry fee: Approx. \$250 per entry for professionals and \$80 per entry for students, with discounts for early submission and additional category entries

## Eligibility

Open to designers worldwide aged 18 or over, including professionals and students, submitting work completed within the past five years.

## Prize

IDA recognizes winners across each discipline with Gold, Silver, and Bronze awards, as well as overall “Designer of the Year” and “Emerging Designer of the Year” titles. Winning projects are selected by an international jury and highlighted as leading examples of design excellence, with official recognition through certificates and award distinctions; the exact prize package structure is confirmed, but detailed current-year benefits may vary.
