Beyond competition, the International Digital Art Contest 2026 serves as a platform for international exposure and cultural exchange. It brings together emerging and established digital artists, fostering a dynamic global community united by a shared passion for digital creativity. Through its curated exhibition and professional jury evaluation, the contest not only recognises artistic excellence but also promotes dialogue around contemporary digital art practices, making it a valuable opportunity for artists seeking visibility, recognition, and engagement within the global art scene.

Eligibility

Open to artists worldwide aged 18 or older submitting original digital artworks created without the use of artificial intelligence.

Prize

Selected works will be exhibited as part of an official exhibition organised by the Academy of Fine Arts, with artists

gaining international exposure and recognition, while final decisions are made by a professional jury whose results are announced publicly; although specific monetary prizes are not emphasized, the primary reward lies in exhibition opportunities, visibility, and inclusion in a curated presentation of contemporary digital art practices.
