The next edition of KINO DER KUNST will be held from *April 22â€”26, 2020* in Munich. Movie theatres and museums all over Munich will present the International Competition as well as supporting programmes, artistsâ€™™ talks, symposia and multi-channel installations.

The theme of this edition is "Forbidden beauty". All entries must reveal an innovative approach to the various forms of cinematographic narration and demonstrate a high technical level.

Films may be of any length and must have been produced after *January 1, 2017*.
