From the Caribbean to the Indian Ocean, Africa to North America, via Europe and South America, *MIBFF* wants to share its most striking black cinematic discoveries while engaging in a wider cultural, social and socio-economic debate. *MIBFF* has become todayâ€™s largest black film festival in Canada.

It is a dynamic, bold and innovative festival that fosters the development of the independent film industry and which offers a new and refreshing look on a growing, rich and original film industry.

Format required for pre-selection: low resolution JPG (2-3 MB). Each participant can submit up to **three proposals**.

The text and poster must be **vector-based** and **editable**. File types: *ai, eps, psd* and *indd*.

There is no entry fee.

Eligibility

Open worldwide to graphic designer, artist, illustrator, poster designer or photographer who loves film and diversity.

Prize

The best poster will be awarded with a prize of **500 CAD** (approx. 375 USD).

Moreover, the winning poster will be featured in all communications and publicity for *MIBFF*'s 13th edition. It will be used for all media and press purposes, including promotional materials, interviews, press conferences, etc.
