There are two main categories:

• The Artist - for professionals, semi-professionals, art students, art tutors and experienced amateur painters.

Only original work will be considered and paintings based on reference photographs must have been taken by the artist or used with the permission of the photographer. Photography, except where incorporated into collage, is not acceptable.

Selected works will be exhibited in two separate galleries at Patchings Art Centre from *June 5* to *July 20, 2014*. Successful entrants will be notified in late April about delivering their work between May 16 and May 28, 2014 to Patchings Art Centre, Nottinghamshire, UK.

The entry fee of £15 (approx. 23 USD) covers up to three entries of two-dimensional works in any media; only one work per entrant will be accepted for exhibition in the Leisure Painter category.

Eligibility

The competition is open to artists worldwide.

Prize
