## Eligibility

Open to amateur and professional photographers worldwide who are at least 18 years old. All entries must relate to climate justice issues and have been taken between August 1, 2023, and August 1, 2024.

## Prize

The 2024 Global Prize Recipient will receive \$5,000 USD. Additionally, the winner, the top 10 finalists, and 20 honorable mentions will have their work exhibited globally, including on the UN.org website on December 10, 2024. Their photographs will also help open the 2025 Right Here, Right Now Global Climate Summit hosted by the University of Oxford on June 5, 2025.
