The reEarth International Art Prize 2025 is a global art competition dedicated to empowering young artists to engage with urgent themes of climate change, sustainability, and ecological awareness. Open to children and youth aged 4 to 25 from every corner of the world, the prize encourages participants to use creative expression as a way to highlight environmental issues and reimagine a more sustainable future. By welcoming diverse art forms such as painting, drawing, illustration, photography, digital media, and Al-generated art, the competition fosters innovation while giving young creators a platform to communicate their visions for a healthier planet.

The competition is designed not only as an art prize but as an educational initiative that bridges creativity and environmental consciousness. Participants are challenged to explore the interconnectedness of humanity and nature, the impact of climate change, and the importance of global collaboration in shaping a sustainable future. Through this process, the reEarth Art Prize inspires young artists to become cultural voices for ecological responsibility, amplifying their perspectives on global challenges through compelling visual storytelling. This broad artistic approach ensures that entries reflect both personal creativity and a shared commitment to sustainability.

A distinctive feature of the 2nd reEarth International Art Prize 2025 is its international exhibition component. Selected artworks will be displayed in prestigious physical exhibitions in Auckland, New Zealand, and Venice, Italy, offering participants global visibility and recognition. In addition, the competition provides extensive online exposure, creating opportunities for artists to reach wider audiences and build their portfolios. With a substantial prize pool of USD \\$50,000, the award combines financial support, recognition, and meaningful opportunities for professional development, making it one of the most impactful international youth art prizes focused on climate, ecology, and the future of our planet.

The entry fee is \$30 per artwork for individuals; schools pay \$24 per artwork for 30–50 works, and \$20 per artwork for 50+ works.

## Eligibility

Open worldwide to children and youth aged 4 to 25.

## Prize

The USD \$50,000 prize pool includes tiered cash awards (first, second, third), Jury's Choice awards, Honourable Mentions, Spotlight selections, and e-certificates for all, with winners exhibiting internationally and receiving online display and promotional support.
