Open worldwide to participants of all ages, including both amateur and professional photographers.

## Prize

The contest offers several cash prizes, including a first prize of \$2,500, a second prize of \$1,000, and a third prize of \$500. Additionally, there are technology and science-specific prizes worth \$750. There are also special awards for youth participants aged 13 to 17, who will receive a surprise gift box of SPIE merchandise. Winners will be notified on 16 October 2024, and the official announcement will be made on 30 October 2024.
