• Fine Art Photography

The judges are seeking dynamic and arresting images that portray a compelling narrative. Entries can be black and white, colour or lens-based media.

Images must be sent over as large jpegs files. All images have been shot between 30 November 2013 and 30 November 2014.

Entry fee:

• 1 - 5 images: £12.50 (£6 Students)
• 6 - 10 images: £25.00 (£12 Students)

Eligibility

Photographers from all over the world, and 18 years of age or older on 1st January 2014, are welcome to submit their entries.

Prize

The winners will have their work showcased in Terry O'Neill exhibitions in UK and overseas and will be featured in the Sunday Times Magazine.

£6500 (approx. 11,130 USD) of cash prizes can be won. The winner gets £3000 and two runners-up £2000 and £1000 respectively.

Moreover, work exhibited at a Gallery to showcase the Awards or showcased in Terry O'Neill Exhibitions should be made available for sale. 50% of sales will go to the photographer/artist.
