## Prize

Winners of the Art of Building competition receive significant recognition and a cash prize. Both the Judges' Choice and the Public's Choice winners are awarded £1,500 each. Additionally, winning photographs gain international exposure through features in various media outlets and exhibitions, showcasing the photographers' work to a global audience.
