The competition's wide media coverage ensures that winning photographers' works are seen by millions worldwide, making it a powerful platform for conservation messaging and artistic exposure.

The entry fee for the adult competition is £30, rising to £35 in the final week before the deadline.

Eligibility

Open to photographers worldwide, both amateur and professional, with entries required to depict non-captive wildlife.

Prize

The competition offers several prestigious awards. The overall winner receives the Grand Title of Wildlife Photographer of the Year, along with a cash prize. Category winners and highly commended entries also receive significant recognition. In addition to monetary rewards, the winning photographs are displayed in a renowned exhibition that tours globally, bringing worldwide exposure to the winning photographers.
